4. OTHER ITEMS WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

4.1. Decision to the Representation given by Dr.Rajesh V G to the 14th BOG

Discussion: SPFU Director, Dr.K.Jayakumar clarified that the Minimum Educational Qualification for an instructor conducting any training and evaluation program should be equal to or more than the Educational qualification specified for the participants. In the above case the minimum educational qualification for teaching faculty is Post Graduation in Engineering. Hence any faculty with Post Graduation or above in Engineering is eligible for claiming TA/DA and Honorarium as per TEQIP rules. (Honorarium Rs 5000/day for IIT /IISc Professors and for all others Rs 3000.). As the person was a co-instructor along with the IIT Professor, he can also travel in the same mode as that availed by the Professor. (Once the person is selected/approved as an instructor by the BOG, then he becomes a guest of the Institute and for guests (unlike our own staff attending out station FDPs), relevant World Bank rules of TEQIP II are applicable. Based on this clarification the BoG has advised the Principal to reimburse the actual TA incurred after collecting all the original mandatory documents like original boarding pass etc. The BOG has also instructed to clarify from Dr.Rajesh V G whether she is having P. G. or Ph.D. The BOG has also directed the principal to reimburse the amount after getting an undertaking from Dr.Rajesh V G, stating that he would reimburse the amount if there is any objection from auditors side. The BOG also decided that if Dr.Rajesh V.G. fails to produce the required documents within a stipulated time, the amount limited to train fare from the parent institution of the resource person to the college can be reimbursed.

Decision:

 The Principal is directed to serve an official order to Dr. Rajesh V.G. asking him to submit all necessary documents to reimburse the flight charge incurred by Ms. Faria Rehman, within 7 days from the date of the order.

- 2. On producing the necessary documents, reimburse the amount after obtaining an undertaking from Dr.Rajesh V G, stating that he would return the amount if there is any audit objection in this matter.
- **3.** Reimburse train fare from parent institution of the resource person to the college, if Dr.Rajesh V.G. fails to submit the required necessary documents..

4.2. Two representations submitted by Dr.Rajesh V G

Dr. Rajesh V G has submitted two representations regarding the following matters:

- Refusing the amount of Rs.4800/-which was given as remuneration for taking remedial classes for S1/S2 semester subjects
- 2. Complaints regarding the absence of 2 faculty members during the faculty development program conducted by IHRD at Model Finishing School from 20th Feb2017 to 24th Feb 2017

Discussion:

The Principal requested time to look into the matter as the complaint was received only on the previous day and the matter may be discussed in the next meeting. Regarding the second complaint the Principal explained the reason for the presence of the two faculty in the college during their course period at MEC . Dr.Preetha Theresa Joy, HOD , CS is the faculty in charge of AICTE related activities. She was called back to the institution for a few hours on 21st as the application for Extension of Approval for the next academic year was needed to be submitted immediately. As per the direction from KTU , Smt.Jibi John , the chief of two subjects of S3 and chairman of two subjects of S1 in the KTU valuation camp at CE Cherthala , was instructed to report at the college on 22nd for a few hours for completing the valuation procedures . In both the cases prior sanction was obtained from the coordinator of the course and also the IHRD FDP coordinator.

Decision:

The BOG expressed satisfaction on the explanation given by the Principal and suggested that such matters need not be discussed in this forum in the future.

Conclusion:

The Hon'ble Chairman in his concluding remarks appreciated the quality of the deliberations of the 14th BOG meeting. He thanked all the members for attending the meeting and contributing to it by

their valuable suggestions and comments. He once again commended the Principal and the TEQIP Cell of CE Cherthala for their good work. He hoped that this good work would continue and some of the major concerns will be taken care of so that the full objective of the project may be met. The Hon'ble Chairman called the meeting to an end at 1.00 PM.
