Report of the Programmes

A one day motivation and orientation programme for the faculty on "How to Excel in Your Profession" was coordinated by Dr. Jobymol Jacob. The talk given by Anoop Kumar, Psychologist, Wellness Hospital, Kochi was highly inspiring and motivating. He talked about different methods of teaching to be adopted for different kinds of students. The session was highly interactive. Forty six faculty members from the college participated in the program and benefited out of it.

An expert talk on 'Open GL – An Introduction' was coordinated by Sony P., Assistant Professor in Computer Science on 27/07/2015. The talk was given by Shailesh S., Senior Software Engineer, Techgencia Software, Infopark, Cherthala. He explained about the various applications of the tool. The basic commands and the usage of the commands in graphic application programs were explained. Twenty faculty from the institute participated and the feedback about the program was excellent.

Another one day workshop on 'Hands on Programming with Open GL' was coordinated by Sony P., Assistant Professor in Computer Science on 31/07/2015. The program was handled by Shailesh S., Senior Software Engineer, Techgencia Software, Infopark, Cherthala. He showed how to create an application program in graphics. Creation of B-Splines, Bezier curves were done using Open GL. He guided how to create an expert program for 2D, 3D transformations. Twenty faculty from the institute participated and the program got an excellent rating.

The Department of Computer Science conducted a four days Faculty Development Program on "Programming Skills in NASM, OpenGL and Python" from 10th to 13th Aug 2015 which is coordinated by Muhammed Illyas H. This training Programme aimed to provide an in-depth understanding of the fundamental aspects of Python, OpenGL and Nasm. The program was inaugurated on 13/08/2015 by Dr. Ignatius Kunjumon, Professor, CUSAT. The session on 'Python and advanced Python Programming in Web Application' was handled by Dr. Ignatius Kunjumon from CUSAT and Mr. Arun Babu from Bitsforge, Kochi. The advertisement in The Hindu was done in the classifieds section. This was done on the basis of the recommendation of Ms. Rupali Jha, Procurement consultant of NPIU and the Director of SPFU. All the EOIs except that of the first firm were shortlisted. The shortlisted firms were invited to make presentations. Request for Proposals were generated. The format for the Technical Proposal was selected as Simplified Technical Proposal. A pre-proposal meeting was held on 7.8.2015, where the shortlisted firms made a presentation of their executive summary, and the action plan for conducting the HIT as well as for ensuring placements. M/s Laxmi Infotech did not attend the pre-proposal meeting. The last date for submitting the Technical and Finance Proposals is 21.8.2015. Once the Technical Proposals are evaluated, World Bank NOC will be further required to proceed to the stage of evaluating Financial Proposals. The consultant will be selected after a combined Technical and Financial Evaluation followed by negotiations. It is proposed to include an expert in Java & Android from Industry in the evaluation team for evaluating the Technical Proposal.
